DATA WAREHOUSE AND BUSINESS INTELLIGENCE REVIEW

The Bank of Papua New Guinea (BPNG) is seeking Expressions of Interest (EOI) from suitably qualified independent consultants to undertake a review of its current Data Warehouse (DW) and Business Intelligence (BI) environment and an assessment of a number of already completed IBM-Cognos based DW/BI projects.

The objectives of the review are to:

- Assess the roadmap, original objectives, initiatives and deliverables based on the requirements identified and accepted.
- Assess or determine whether the Bank of PNG achieved the outcomes (benefits) from the projects delivered.
- Assess the design and development methods employed.
- Assess the quality and usefulness of the documentation produced for each of the solutions delivered to date.
- Assess the information requirements as specified, and the processes and systems in use to form an understanding of specific information needs by different functions of the Bank.
- Based on the above give an estimate of time and cost of the project at its conclusion.
- Assess the methods, development techniques and documentation delivered for each of these applications developed to date.
- Determine whether the methods or techniques applied are consistent with industry accepted best practices.
- Provide an estimate of the cost of effort and expertise that would be required if these solutions were to be redeveloped.
- Document review findings and make recommendations to the BPNG Executive Committee on whether to continue with solution or seek an alternative data warehouse/business intelligence toolset.
